Most venomous animals either bite with their mouths (examples are spiders and snakes) or sting with a modified egg-laying organ (called an ovipositor) or with a separate stinging organ. Some venomous animals neither bite nor sting. Centipedes can drip toxin on an open wound. Blister beetles can rub a toxin on the skin.

Common Terrestrial Venomous Snakes of Taiwan

Many snakes, including whip snakes; racers; cotton-mouths; garter snakes; and kingsnakes, eat snakes. Of these snake eaters, kingsnakes are the most notorious. Kingsnakes are especially interesting because they are relatively tolerant (immune) to the venom of our native poisonous snakes. Rattlesnakes recognize kingsnakes and make no effort to bite them.
